



Election Clerk Fee Schedule 2024 – 2027

HONORARIUM

Paid monthly, from the time of appointment until the Writ of Election is issued, unless appointment is terminated at an earlier date. Honorarium allows for 3 hours of activities, including general communications with Elections Alberta or returning office staff. **\$82.50**

TRAINING

Hourly fee for attending a training session called by the Chief Electoral Officer **\$27.50**

Hourly fee for travelling to a training session **\$27.50**

PRE-ELECTION & ENUMERATION

Hourly fee for pre-election and pre-enumeration activities, up to specified maximums **\$27.50**

Hourly fee for travelling within the electoral division, up to specified maximums **\$27.50**

Hourly fee for target enumeration activities, up to specified maximums **\$27.50**

ELECTION

Fee for conducting an election or referendum vote in an electoral division during a provincial electoral event. Fee includes activities conducted from the opening to the closing of the returning office (approx. 2-3 months). **\$11,100.00**

Fee for conducting a by-election or recall vote in an electoral division. Fee includes pre-event preparation activities, as well as activities conducted from the opening to the close of the returning office (approx. 6 weeks). **\$11,100.00**

Hourly fee to attend a judicial recount, if applicable **\$27.50**

Fee when a writ of election is issued, and a poll is not held **Pro-rated based on hours**

TRAVEL

Mileage per kilometre (not including travel to work) **\$0.550**

Accommodation (if with a friend or family member while on travel status) **\$20.15**

Accommodation (receipted) **PER RECEIPT**

Daily Per Diem **\$7.35**

Breakfast (if your departure time is 7:30 am or earlier, or return is 7:30 am or later) **\$13.00**

Lunch (if your departure time is 1:00 pm or earlier, or return is 1:00 pm or later) **\$17.00**

Dinner (if your departure time is 6:30 pm or earlier, or return is 6:30 pm or later) **\$27.00**
